

# STUDENT SURVEY ANALYSIS

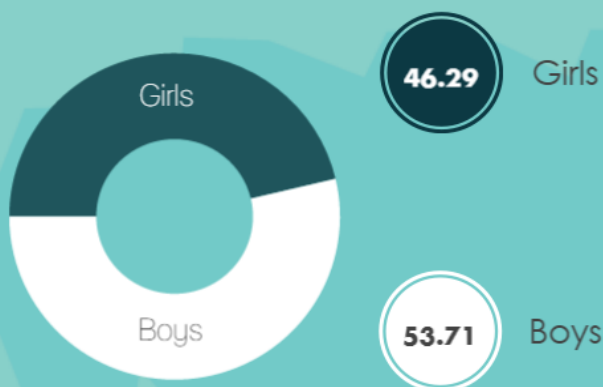

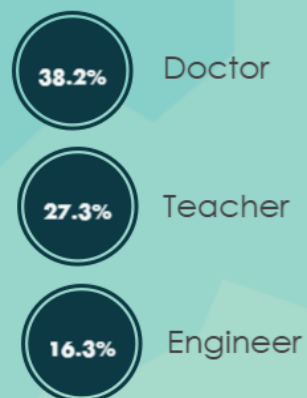
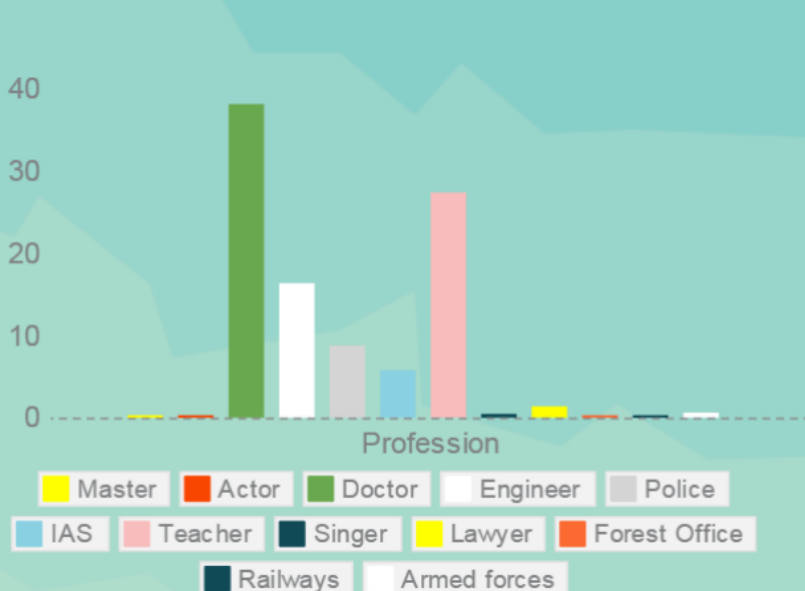
## Number of people who took the survey

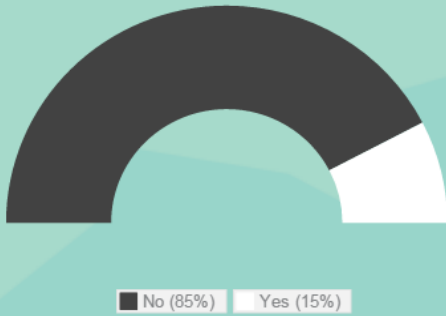


## What do you wish to become in life

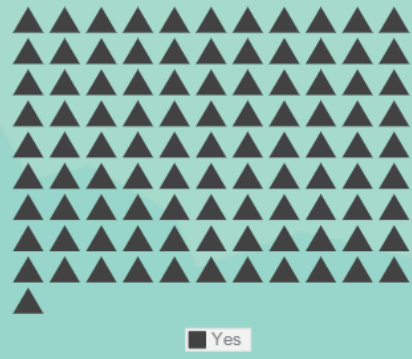


More than 50% of the students are taking up usually jobs like doctors, teachers and engineers

Do you know what courses you need to take up to reach your goal?

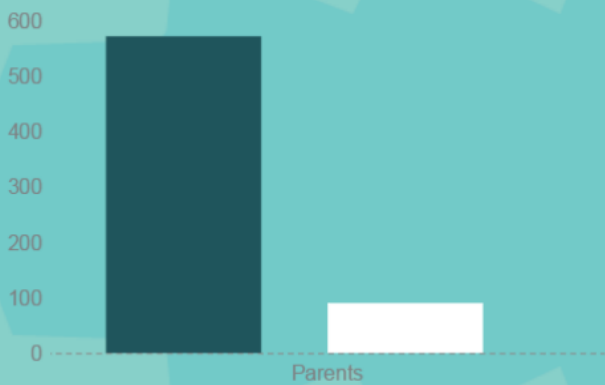


Does your school provide career guidance?



85% of the students do not know what courses to take up after 10th grade to reach their goal. Ironically 100% of the students answered that their school provides career guidance.

Do your parents allow you to take your career decisions?



13.67% of parents do not allow their children to take their career decisions

Do your parents support you in your further education?



5.75% parents are not allowing their children to study further



9 out of every 10 children cannot afford their further education

Out of 661 students 152 students do not know which course to take up after their 10th grade



Do your mandal have colleges that provide the courses that you want to take up?



Are you aware of colleges in nearby mandals that provide the courses that you want?



Out 661 students 514 students say that their mandal does not have colleges that provide courses that they want to take up and 10% of the students do not know the colleges available in their near by mandals as well.



None of the students know what kinds of loans are available and the process to apply to any of them
